Title of task	我的房间 Wǒ de fángjiān (My room)			
Task details				
Description of task	Students demonstrate their knowledge and understanding of vocabulary and grammatical structures related to describing a bedroom. In Part A they demonstrate their reading comprehension skills by reading a text about a boy's room which is written in Chinese and convey their understanding by labelling a diagram of Jake's room in Chinese. In Part B students use a stimulus drawing of their room to describe their room to the teacher in a one on one short oral interview.			
Type of assessment	Summative			
Purpose of assessment	This assessment aims to determine student learning at the time of the assessment. It is designed to allow students to demonstrate their skills to comprehend written text about a bedroom and convey their understanding by labelling a diagram of the room in Chinese. Students also demonstrate their speaking skills by describing their room with the support of a stimulus drawing and answering questions in a short interview with the teacher.

Prior to administering the task, the students will need to be:

- taught context-related vocabulary and grammatical structures, including:
 - nouns for furniture and things commonly found in a bedroom
 - adjectives 好,坏,大,小
 - using measurement words
 - describing objects, e.g. 我的房间很大;我的花园很漂亮.

Part A - Jake's Room

Students read the passage about Jake's room and then using the word list label the diagram with Chinese characters.

Part B - My room

Students draw a picture of their room and then use it to tell their teacher about their room in a one-on-one interview. The teacher will ask the students some simple questions that relate to the picture of their room.

Teachers will give the student a chance to tell them as much as they can about their room. Then the teachers will ask the student a few questions in Chinese that relate to their room picture, such as: Where are your clothes? What colour is your bed? Do you like reading? What's this? Do you like the colour blue? What is this?

Part A – Jake 的房间 Jake's Room

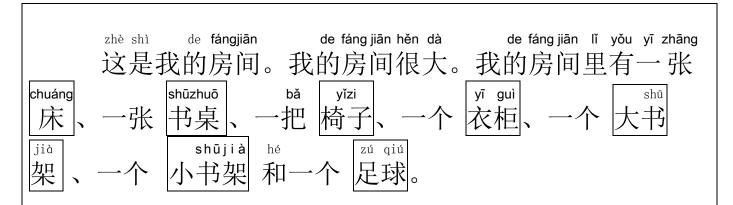
Jake has written up a plan for where he wants everything to go in his room.

Please note that 床 has been labelled for you on the floor plan.

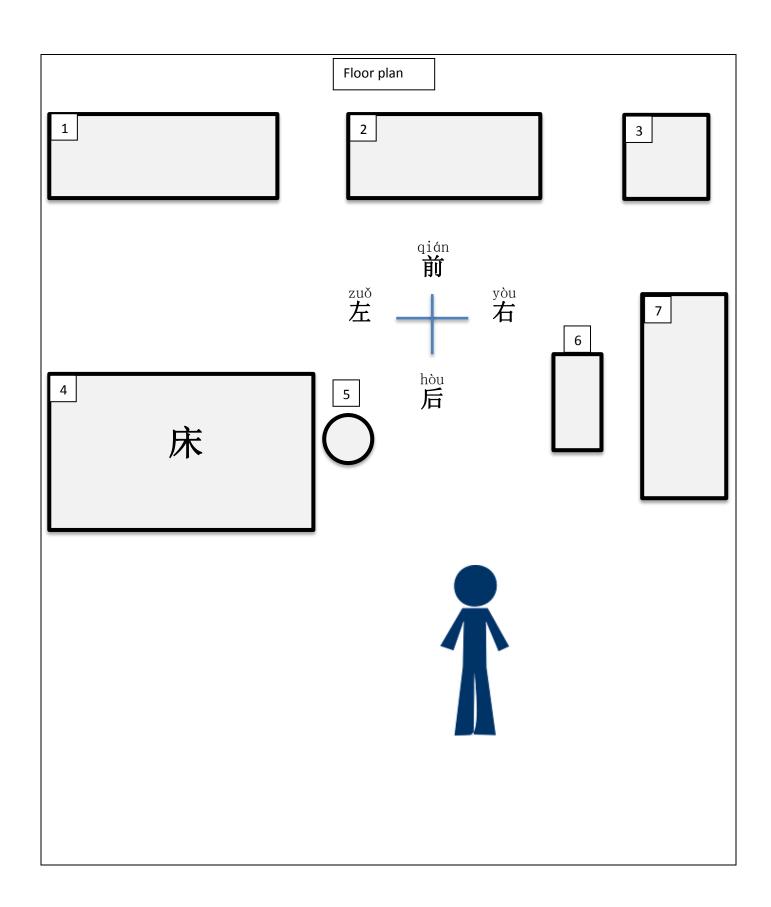

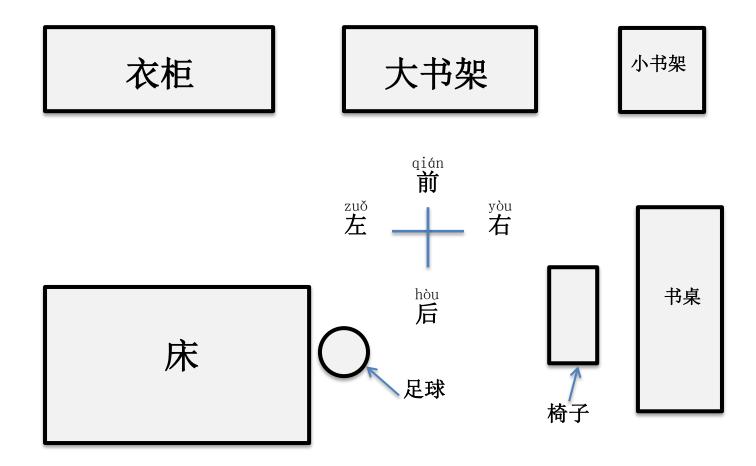
