Task details	
Description of task	Students demonstrate their knowledge and understanding of vocabulary, language structures and grammatical items related to animate objects. In Part A they also demonstrate their skills in comprehending spoken text by drawing a
	picture of an alien based on the description given by the little girl in the text.
	In Part B they demonstrate their skills in speaking Chinese by describing to their teacher the picture provided to them of the alien.
Type of assessment	Summative
Purpose of assessment	This assessment aims to determine student learning at the time of assessment. It establishes information on the students' ability to comprehend spoken text to convey in written form a simple description of an alien. It also establishes information on their ability to describe animate objects in simple, modelled spoken language.
Assessment strategy	Short response – listen for information in a spoken text Oral performance – provide a description

Instructions for teacher

Prior to administering the task, students will need to be:

- taught context-related vocabulary and grammatical structures, including:
 - body parts, for example, 头,头发,眼睛,眉毛,鼻子,耳朵,身体,嘴巴,腿
 - adjectives, for example, 大,小,长,短,胖,瘦
 - colours, for example, 黑色,棕色
 - describing sentences, for example, 我的眉毛很长;他的头发很短;她有黑色的头发; 我有两只棕色的眼睛
- taught the textual conventions of an interview, and be provided with opportunities to practise them.

Task

Part A: Alien

Provide students with a copy of Part A of the task and a pencil.

Task administration script

READ ALOUD

Listen carefully as I tell you a Chinese story about an alien that visited a little girl.

You need to draw a picture that matches the description that the little girl gives her dad in the story.

You need to listen carefully to the adjectives ('describing words') and make sure your drawing shows me that you understand.

If I say something is big, make it very big.

If I say something is small, make it very small.

Keep your drawing inside the box on your page.

I will read through the story twice.

Let's begin.


