To assist teachers in implementing the new curriculum in the learning areas there are resources available under the accordion *Curriculum to be implemented in 2025*.

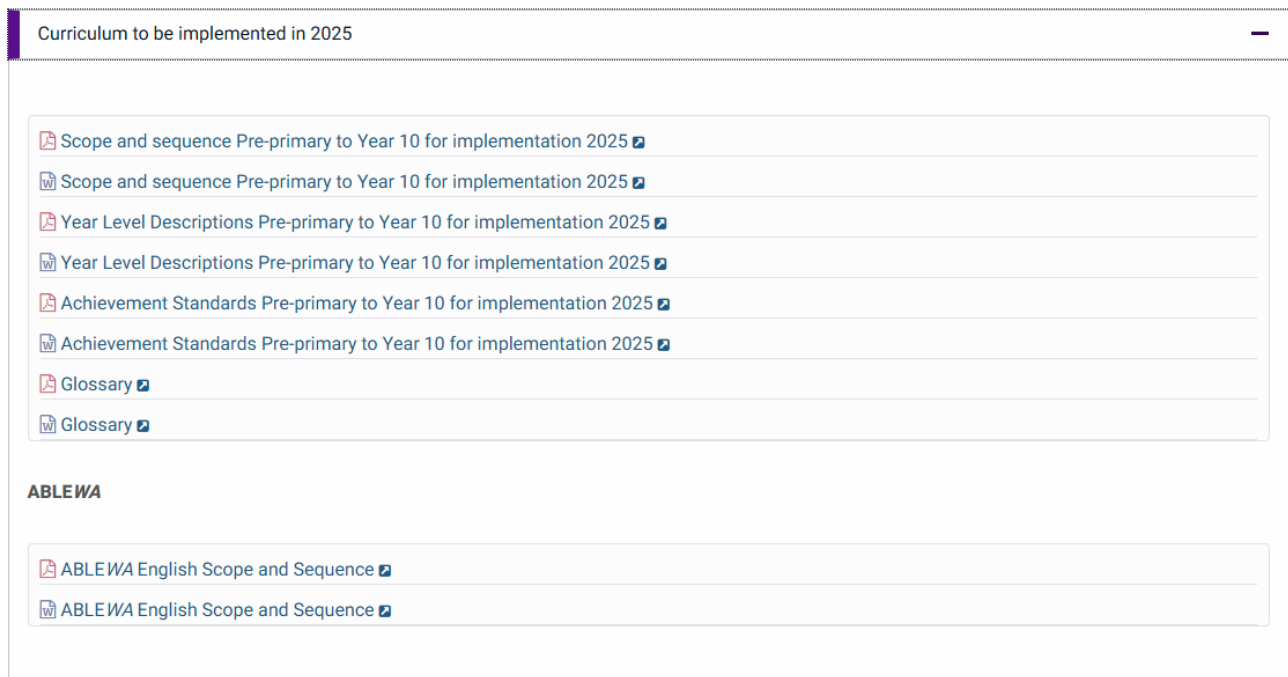


To expand the accordion, click the ‘+’ button. You can view or print any of the documents housed under the accordion.

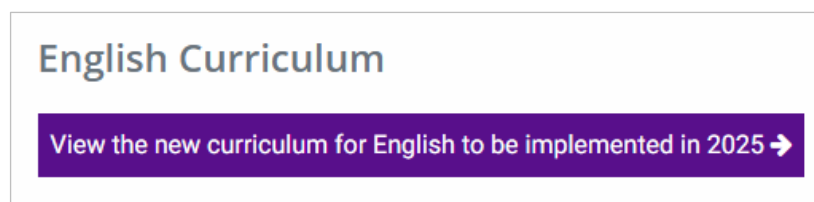

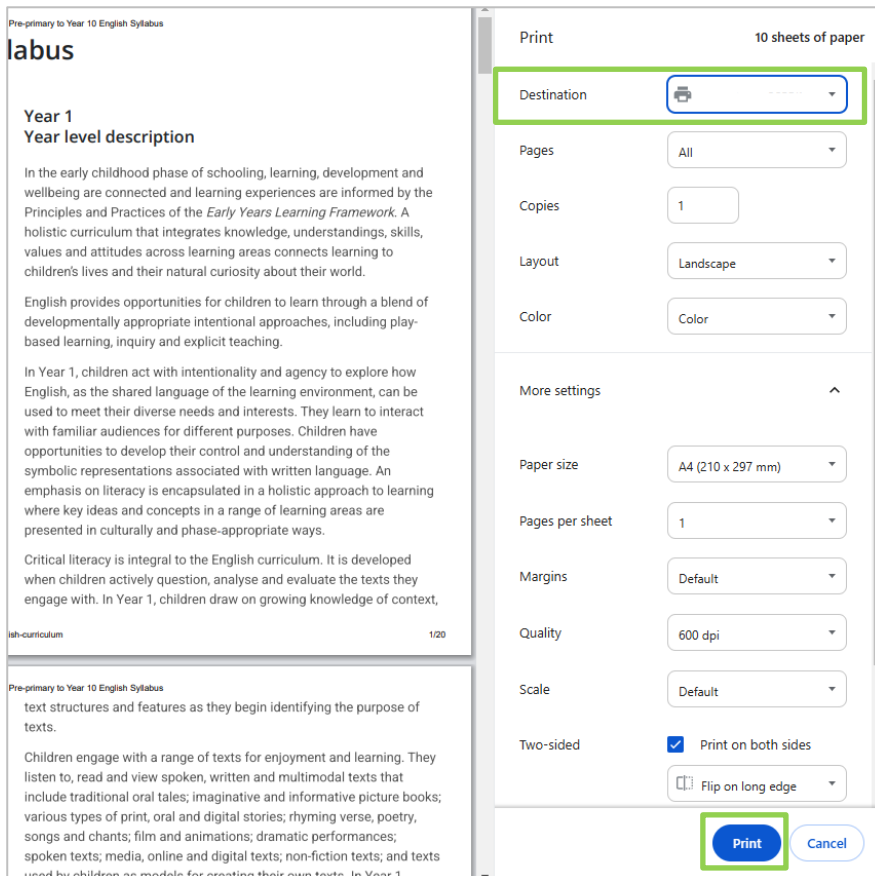

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To print the page, click on the **Print page** button.



In the **Print** window, click the box next to **Destination** (highlighted in the screenshot below) and select your preferred printer from the list. Make any additional setting or option changes, then click the **Print** button in the bottom-right corner.



To create a PDF, choose the **Save as PDF** option (highlighted in the screenshot below) instead of a physical printer. Make any additional setting or option changes, then click the **Save** button in the bottom-right corner.
