Communication	The Authority provides information via the <i>K-10 circular</i> about the assessment process and invites proponents to notify their intention to seek recognition of an alternative curriculum (and/or reporting on student achievement).	First K-10circular in Term 2 (5 May 2022)
Notice of Intention	The Authority receives notice of a proponent's intention to seek recognition of an alternative curriculum (and/or reporting on student achievement) via the Notice of Intention link found at https://k10outline.scsa.wa.edu.au/home/teaching/alternative-curriculum-recognition . The Authority receives the Notice of Intention and advises the proponent of this.	Link opens commencement of Term 2. Link closes 3PM Friday 3 June
Submission	The Authority's Submission link is used to submit a full application to the Authority at https://k10outline.scsa.wa.edu.au/home/teaching/alternative-curriculum-recognition . The Authority receives the Submission and advises the proponent of this.	Link opens Monday 20 June Link closes 3PM Friday 12 August.
Review	The Authority's Alternative Curriculum/Reporting Recognition Review Panel establishes a schedule to review the submissions. The Authority Alternative Curriculum/Reporting Recognition Review Panel meet. The Alternative Curriculum/Reporting Recognition Review Panel provides recommendations to the Authority's Curriculum and Assessment Committee and Board including reasons for recommendation to place on the <i>Register of Recognised Curriculum</i> or otherwise.	By end of September By end of October November/ December
Notification	The Authority provides the proponent with information about outcomes of the assessment process and updates the <i>Register of Recognised Curriculum</i> .	By mid-December
