Sample assessment task

Hindi: Second Language – Year 5

Title of task	मेरा परिचय (Let me introduce myself)
Description of task	<p>Students demonstrate their knowledge and understanding of vocabulary, language structures and grammatical items related to their home, neighbourhood and local community.</p> <p>In Part A, they demonstrate their skills in comprehending written Hindi text by reading and responding to questions from a Hindi-speaking penpal.</p> <p>In Part B, they demonstrate their skills in writing by composing an informative and descriptive email to their pen pal.</p>
Type of assessment	Summative
Purpose of assessment	This assessment aims to determine students' learning at the time of the assessment. It establishes their ability to comprehend written texts, gathering and comparing information and supporting details and conveying this information to others. It also establishes their ability to interact in written form, exchanging information with others.
Assessment strategy	Short response – read for information in a written text Short response – complete an email response
Evidence to be collected	Completed task sheets
Suggested time	Part A – 30 minutes Part B – 25 minutes

Content description

Content from the Western Australian Curriculum

Communicating

Initiate interactions with teacher and peers orally and in writing to exchange information about their home, neighbourhood and local community

Engage in individual and collaborative tasks that involve organising displays, planning outings, conducting events, such as performances, or activities, such as building models, and completing transactions in places, such as a café or a market

Understanding

Generate language for a range of purposes in simple spoken and written texts by recognising and using context-related vocabulary and elements of the Hindi grammatical system, including:

- recognising that certain words are written differently from how they are pronounced; for example, written बहन is pronounced बेहेन
- using singular and plural forms of nouns and pronouns; for example, मैं; हम; तुम; सब; वह; वे
- using compulsion affecting actions such as हमें विद्यालय जाना होगा।; तुम्हें निबंध लिखना पड़ेगा।
- using सवा (quarter past) and पोने (quarter to) when telling the time
- developing number knowledge for 61 to 80 and using a dozen (दर्जन), a decade (दशक) and a century (शतक)

Task preparation

Prior learning

Students have prior knowledge of and exposure to:

- a variety of texts related to introducing fictional characters, such as Raj from *Demon Dentist* by David Walliams
- vocabulary related to introducing oneself, such as परिवार, पसंद
- answering literal and inferential questions based on comprehension texts
- grammatical structures, including tenses and genders
- the textual conventions of a letter/email.

Assessment differentiation

Teachers should differentiate their teaching and assessment to meet the specific learning needs of their students, based on their level of readiness to learn and their need to be challenged.

Where appropriate, teachers may either scaffold or extend the scope of the assessment tasks.

Assessment task

Assessment conditions

Task is to be completed by students working individually.

Resources

- Task sheets
- Bilingual dictionary

Instructions for teacher

Prior to administering the task, students will need to be:

- taught vocabulary related to introducing oneself, such as परिवार, पसंद
- familiar with answering literal and inferential questions based on comprehension texts
- taught grammatical structures, including tenses, genders and compound sentences
- familiar with the textual conventions of a letter/email, and provided with opportunities to practise writing them
- exposed to some synonyms, such as ज़्यादा and बहुत; अच्छा and पसंद
- taught the textual conventions of an email/letter and provided with opportunities to practise writing them.

Activities to scaffold the task

Provide opportunities for students to engage in language practice and writing activities to help them internalise the language, skills and cultural knowledge they need for this task, such as:

- creating a 'Wanted' poster describing a character in a fairytale or another children's story, such as Goldilocks, the wolf in *The Three Little Pigs*, or Aslan in *The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe*, using descriptive words and phrases
- playing a guessing game where one student stands up and describes a person in five words or phrases. The other students try to guess who that person is, based on their appearance, hobbies, personality etc.
- writing an email to a person of their choice, using the conventions of email writing.

Task

Part A: मेरा नाम शायरी है

Provide students with the text शायरी का पत्र and the questions associated with the text.

Advise students that they have 30 minutes to complete the task.

Instruct students to silently read the text for five minutes, after which you will read it aloud to them.

Instruct students to use the information in the text to respond in English to the questions which follow.

Advise students that they may look up unfamiliar words in a bilingual dictionary.

Part B: शायरी का पत्र

Provide students with the writing task शायरी का पत्र and ask them to complete the email to their penpal, conveying information about themselves, their family, home, pet, and school and leisure activities.

Advise students that they may use a bilingual dictionary if required.

Advise students that they have 25 minutes to complete the task.

Instructions to students
