Communication	The Authority provides information via the <i>K-6</i> and <i>7-12 circulars</i> about the assessment process and invites proponents to notify their intention to seek recognition of an alternative curriculum (and/or reporting on student achievement). Notice of Intention	The Authority receives notice of a proponent's intention to seek recognition of an alternative curriculum (and/or reporting on student achievement) via the Notice of Intention link – will be available at https://k10outline.scsa.wa.edu.au/home/teaching/alternative-curriculum-recognition . The Authority receives the Notice of Intention and advises the proponent of this.	Link opens commencement of Term 2 (Monday, 28 April 2025) Link closes 3 pm Friday, 6 June
Submission	The Authority's Submission link is used to submit a full application to the Authority and will be available at https://k10outline.scsa.wa.edu.au/home/teaching/alternative-curriculum-recognition . The Authority receives the Submission and advises the proponent of this.	Link opens Monday, 16 June Link closes 3 pm Friday, 8 August
Review	The Authority's Alternative Curriculum/Reporting Recognition Review Panel establishes a schedule to review the submissions. The Authority Alternative Curriculum/Reporting Recognition Review Panel meet. The Alternative Curriculum/Reporting Recognition Review Panel provides recommendations to the Authority's Curriculum and Assessment Committee and Board including reasons for recommendation to place on the Register of Recognised Curriculum or otherwise.	By end of September By end of October November/ December
Notification	The Authority provides the proponent with information about outcomes of the assessment process and updates the <i>Register of Recognised Curriculum</i> .	By mid- December
