Subject	Indonesian: Second Language
Title of task	<i>Tentang saya!</i> (About me!)
Task details	
Description of task	<p>Students demonstrate their knowledge and understanding of vocabulary, language structures and grammatical items related to information about themselves, their friends and their interests.</p> <p>In Part A students demonstrate their skills in comprehending a written text by completing responses to questions in English.</p> <p>In Part B students demonstrate their skills in speaking by responding to interview questions about themselves in Indonesian.</p>
Type of assessment	Summative
Purpose of assessment	This assessment aims to determine student learning at the time of the assessment. It establishes information on the students' ability to comprehend written text and convey this information to others in a variety of ways. It also establishes information on their ability to speak in Indonesian, using context-related vocabulary and elements of the Indonesian grammatical system.
Assessment strategy	Short response – read for information in written text Oral performance – respond to interview questions in Indonesian
Evidence to be collected	Completed task sheet Audio visual recording of the interview
Suggested time	Part A – 35 minutes Part B – 15 minutes to complete the table, 10 minutes practise with a partner and 2–3 minutes for the interview

Task preparation	
Prior learning	<p>Students have prior knowledge of, and exposure to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a variety of texts, including conversations and interviews related to introductions, self, family, friends and interests • vocabulary related to self, family, friends and interests • grammatical items, including: pronouns, possessive pronouns, greeting and farewelling, prepositions, locating events in time, seeking information using interrogatives, describing actor, action and object using subject-verb-object construction, expressing emotion, noun-adjective phrases, base words, simple conjunctions, <i>ber-</i> and <i>me-</i> verbs, describing things using acronyms • textual conventions of an interview.
Assessment differentiation	<p>Teachers should differentiate their teaching and assessment to meet the specific learning needs of their students, based on their level of readiness to learn and their need to be challenged.</p> <p>Where appropriate, teachers may either scaffold or extend the scope of the assessment tasks.</p>

Instructions for teacher

Prior to administering the task, students will need to have prior knowledge of, and exposure to:

- context-related vocabulary related to self, family, friends and interests
- grammatical items, including:
 - pronouns and possessive pronouns
 - greeting and farewelling
 - using simple prepositions
 - locating events in time
 - seeking information using interrogatives
 - describing actor, action and object using subject-verb-object construction
 - expressing emotion
 - noun-adjective phrases
 - simple base words, such as *suka* and *mau*
 - simple conjunctions, such as *dan*
 - *ber-* and *me-* verbs
 - describing things using acronyms, such as *SMP*
- the textual conventions of an interview, and the opportunity to practise them.

Task

Part A: *Kenalkan*

Provide students with Part A of the task.

Students read the conversation *Kenalkan* and answer the questions that follow in English.

They may look up any unfamiliar vocabulary in a dictionary.

Allow students 35 minutes to complete Part A.

Part B: *Wawancara*

Provide students with Part B of the task.

Students work independently to complete the table in full sentences with their personal information.

They may look up any unfamiliar vocabulary in a dictionary.

Allow students 15 minutes to complete the table and 10 minutes to practice their answers with a partner.

Inform students that during the interview you will ask a number of the questions but will not necessarily follow the order of the questions as they appear in the table.

Inform students that they have 2–3 minutes for the interview and that it will be recorded.

Instructions to students

Tentang saya!

Part A: Kenalkan

13 marks

Read the conversation between Restu and Sofyan, two students who meet for the first time on their way to school. Answer the questions that follow in English.

Look up any unfamiliar vocabulary in a dictionary.

You have 35 minutes to complete Part A.

Restu: Selamat pagi! Siapa nama kamu?

Sofyan: Selamat pagi! Nama saya Sofyan. Kamu siapa?

Restu: Saya Restu. Kamu kelas berapa?

Sofyan: Saya kelas 1 SMP.

Restu: Saya juga kelas 1 SMP. Umur saya sebelas tahun. Umur kamu berapa?

Sofyan: Saya berumur sebelas tahun juga. Hari ulang tahun saya pada tanggal empat belas April.

Restu: Wah, tanggal ulang tahun saya hampir sama dengan tanggal ulang tahun kamu! Hari ulang tahun saya tanggal dua belas April.

Sofyan: Asyik! Berarti kita bisa merayakannya bersama-sama ya!

Restu: Iya*!

Sofyan: Kamu tinggal di mana?

Restu: Orang tua saya tinggal di Lombok, tetapi saya tinggal di sini, di Singaraja dengan paman saya.

Sofyan: Oh begitu. Orang tua saya dari Singaraja.

Restu: Kamu bersekolah di mana?

Sofyan: Saya bersekolah di SMP Sukawati.

Restu: Kalau saya bersekolah di SMP Raj Yamuna.

Sofyan: Itu sekolah swasta ya?

Restu: Iya benar. Kamu berasal dari Bali, bukan?

Sofyan: Iya, saya orang Bali dari Singaraja. Kalau kamu?

Restu: Saya berasal dari Lampung, tetapi orang tua saya pindah ke Lombok ketika saya masih kecil. Berapa orang di keluarga kamu?

Sofyan: Hanya ada tiga orang; Bapak, Ibu dan saya. Kalau kamu?

Restu: Ada banyak orang di keluarga saya! Ada Bapak, Ibu, adik laki-laki dan kakak perempuan saya.

Sofyan: Tidak banyak ah! Apa hobi kamu?

Restu: Hobi saya membaca buku. Kamu apa hobinya?

Sofyan: Saya suka sekali bermain sepak bola.

Restu: Ayo! Kita siap-siap bus sudah datang. Sampai jumpa Sofyan!
