## Students with disabilities

The Disability Discrimination Act 1992 and the Disability Discrimination Act 2005 require educational institutions to provide students with disabilities with the same opportunities as students without disabilities.



Many students with disabilities will learn in the same way as other students. However, some students may require additional support to ensure they can access the curriculum and participate in learning activities.



In some cases, curriculum modifications may be required to ensure that all students have access to the curriculum. These modifications may include providing additional support, such as extra time to complete tasks, or providing alternative ways of presenting information. The curriculum is designed to be flexible and to meet the needs of all students.
