In the Western Australian Curriculum, the Humanities and Social Sciences area comprises four subjects: English, Mathematics, Geography and History.

By studying Humanities and Social Sciences, students develop critical thinking skills; they learn to question, think critically, and communicate their ideas effectively.

Thinking about, reflecting on, and discussing the key historical, geographical, and social factors involved, and the impact of these factors on the lives of people in the past and present.

The Humanities and Social Sciences curriculum provides students with the knowledge and skills they need to understand the world around them and how people can make a positive impact on the world.
