Dance knowledge and skills to

- develop confidence and self-expression through dance
- apply the elements of dance to create dance that communicates
- develop aesthetic appreciation of contemporary and traditional dance
- develop respect for and appreciation of different dance forms and cultures of dance
- create and perform dance for an informed audience

Drama

Drama knowledge and skills to develop:

- confidence, empathy, and respect for others
- experience, take risks, and be creative
- knowledge of how to use drama processes, conventions, and contemporary drama to communicate
- knowledge of the creative process and the role of the audience
- knowledge of traditional and contemporary drama and active participation

Media Arts

Media Arts knowledge and skills that students develop:

- confidence to participate and communicate
- aesthetic knowledge to express ideas, create and produce media art
- creative and critical thinking skills as producers and consumers
- awareness of the social and cultural context of media art, including using social media
